

Furōto (フロート)

Essence Statement:

Your mother tree is wilting and sent you to fulfill her mission; regrow the world! Grab your tea and relax while you play as a leaf floating through the air collecting rain drops to sprout new trees. The more rain you collect, the larger your tree will grow. Throughout your mission, you will be faced with environmental obstacles, such as ice that may disrupt your gathering.

Summary:

Furōto is a single player relaxation game where the player plays as a leaf with the solo objective of collecting as much rain as possible to grow the largest tree. The player uses the touch screen to swipe which controls the leaf's direction. The leaf will be difficult to control because it is replicating the effect of blowing from the wind.

As soon as it stops raining, the player will water the dirt to grow their tree. The tree will grow larger the more rain you have collected.

Throughout the game, the player will encounter environmental challenges that may disrupt their final gathered amount. These obstacles may abrupt the way the player plays the game to collect rain. For example: In one of the early levels, the player will have to float around hail. If the player collides with the hail, it will freeze the player. When the player is in a frozen state, their speed will be slowed down and they will not be able to collect water. To get the leaf out of the frozen state, the player must tap on the leaf until the ice breaks.

As the game progresses, the environmental obstacles will become more frequent; however the game will introduce new benefit mechanics such as the sun which will increase the leaf size for 10 seconds and wind that will increase the leaf's speed for 5 seconds.

Furōto's overall experience relies on making the player feel relaxed and at ease while creating replay value.

Key Features:

Collecting: You collect the rain water

• Watering: You water the dirt to grow your tree

Obstacle Avoidance: Avoid the ice



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
